

English

This term your child will have many opportunities to learn about our local area and London through key texts; such as *'Who lives here?' by Julia Donaldson* as well as listening to and reading a wide range of free verse poems. Throughout the term, they will be able to sequence sentences to form short narratives and be able to use a range of story language to enhance their vocabulary

Connected Curriculum—Geography

We will be exploring our school and our local area. The children will use maps to help them investigate key features of the local area. Throughout the term, the children will develop their mapping skills and begin to understand how to use basic symbols in a simple key. Children will also learn to name, locate and identify the countries and capital cities of the UK.

Science

This term the children will find out about different 'materials'. They will investigate a variety of everyday materials and be able to identify the difference between an object and a material and the material the object is made from. The children will work scientifically to investigate which materials are waterproof and will apply this knowledge to make a rain coat.

PE

We are developing our skills through multi skills, spatial and body awareness. We will be exploring different ways to travel on low level equipment as well as exploring different body shapes, such as stretching and tucked positions

Computing

The children will be using the iPad to take photos of still objects. We will look at photos to discuss what we have captured and we will explore different ways of manipulating images.

Maths

This term your child will focusing on number and place value. Children will practise counting forwards and backwards from a given number below 20, and compare and order numbers. They will learn to read and write numbers to 20.

Children will also have a focus on addition and subtraction. They will learn number bonds to 10 using a systematic approach and compare number bonds. Children will use manipulatives, number lines and the counting on method to add together and add more. They will also learn how to subtract using the crossing out method.

Religious Education

We will begin the term by writing our class rules and how these rules connect to our values. This leads into learning about special promises that we make to trusted people as well as promises people make to God.

PSHE

Developing a sense of self within our local community and how we fit into it. We will look at developing a sense of what it means to stay safe and why and also ways in which can stay safe on the internet, at home and within our local community.

Art

The children will have the opportunity to learn about a range of different artists and describe what they can see, as well as making simple comparisons between works on the same theme

Music

This term the children will have weekly music lessons where they will focus on learning about pitch, pace and notation when singing and making music.
