Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to welcome you all back after the summer break. I am looking forward to getting to know you and your child and I am sure we will have a term full of fun and learning! The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the expectations for the term ahead so that you can help support your child's learning at home.

This focus this term will be **The Great Fire of London** and all of your child's learning will be linked to this topic where possible. Attached you will find an overview outlining the areas of learning we intend to cover this term. A copy of this document can be found on our website.

PE lessons will take place on **Thursday and Friday** however, your child's PE kit should come in each Monday and should be taken home each Friday; We ask that your child has their PE kit in school all week so that they are prepared should any additional PE lessons be required. Watches and all jewellery, including earrings, will need to be removed before the PE lesson to prevent injury.

In Year Two, **homework** will be set weekly. The children will receive homework every **Friday** which should be returned completed the following **Monday**. Children are also expected to read every day. Reading for even 10 minutes a day with your child can help to improve their skills and reading helps children across the curriculum.

Dates for your diary: Our start of the year **meet and greet** will take place on **Monday 9th September at 3:30pm** - I do hope that you will join us, to hear more about our learning! This term Year One will be sharing their learning in a class assembly on **Friday 22nd November 2024** here in school, which you are all welcome to attend. A number of trips and visits are being planned for the term ahead – more information will be sent home once arrangements have been confirmed.
